Endorsement of Teresa Leger Fernandez for Third Congressional District of New Mexico

WHEREAS, Taos Pueblo maintains a Traditional Tribal Governmental structure consisting of the Tribal Council, the Governor's Office and the War Chief's Office; and

WHEREAS, Teresa Leger Fernandez is a candidate for the Third Congressional District of New Mexico and has asked the Tribal Council for our endorsement; and

WHEREAS, Teresa has served Taos Pueblo as its General Counsel with integrity, wisdom and passion for assisting Taos Pueblo achieve its goals of preserving its financial, cultural and land resources, protecting its sovereign rights and promoting business development; and

WHEREAS, Teresa has served Taos Pueblo with a clear understanding of our tribal sovereignty and

deep knowledge of our community needs; and

WHEREAS, Teresa has used her financing background and economic development experience to assist

the Business Development Team and Taos Pueblo develop new businesses that will generate jobs and

financial resources to fund services for our community; and

WHEREAS, Teresa's dedication to improving voter access and to voting rights act issues is beneficial

to not only Taos Pueblo but the entire state of New Mexico since access to the polls is a fundamental

foundation of democracy; and

WHEREAS, Teresa has pursued renewable energy legislation and projects which will help our State

and our Nation address the climate crisis we must face and solve;
